



## **Pupil Premium (PP) – Ofsted releases new figures**

A new document from Ofsted -The Pupil Premium: how schools are spending the funding successfully to maximise achievement (Feb 13).

Many case studies are of effective practice drawn from schools with high numbers of ethnic minority learners, and high proportions of bilingual learners.

A number show work with relatively newly arrived bilingual learners.

This document details how some schools are using PP to employ staff to provide EAL language teaching and EAL related literacy support.

Schools can read this to see what other schools are doing to support EAL pupils who qualify for PP.

Of course this begs the question 'What about those children who are learning English but do not qualify for PP? '
